Dear Valued Patron,

During the 2022 crop year, ALCIVIA may be applying pesticides (herbicides/fungicides/insecticides) to your crops, which may also include applications of impregnated crop nutrients to your fields. Enclosed is information you should have readily available until the pesticide application(s) is completed. A free copy of the pesticide label and Safety Data Sheet (SDS) are available upon request or may be found at <https://www.cdms.net/Label-Database>

The EPA Workers Protection Standard (WPS) and Wisconsin Pesticide Use and Control Rule (ATCP 29) requires a licensed commercial application business to provide its customers with both pre-application pesticide information for you and your workers and post application precautions. WPS requires ALCIVIA to make you aware of:

- Location and description of areas to be treated.
- Date of application, and estimated start time and end time of the applications.
- Product name, EPA registration number, active ingredients, and re-entry interval (REI).
- Whether the product label requires both oral warnings and treated area posting.
- All other safety requirements on labeling for workers or other people.

ATCP 29 requires ALCIVIA to provide post application precautions in a timely manner. ALCIVIA is now able to notify customers of these precautions via electronic means (email or text). Please contact any of our agronomy team members with your contact information if you have not already done so. Please be aware that there are limited exceptions to entering a treated area before the expiration of the REI. For further information on the WPS, please contact your local UW-Extension Agent, WDATCP at (608) 224-4500 or the EPA. We are also asking for your help in notifying ALCIVIA of any sensitive areas that may be near fields on which pesticides will be applied. These areas may include, but are not limited to, gardens, vineyards, fruit trees, beehives, sweet corn patches, and sensitive property owners. If you are aware of these areas, please notify your agronomist or nearest agronomy office so proper precautions can be taken.
