#### **WEANING PENS SET FOR SUCCESS:**

- Feed bunk perpendicular to the fence line to encourage eating
- Provide 1 foot bunk space per calf
- Water perpendicular to the fenceline when possible
- Ensure access to clean water
- Place stress tub along the fence line away from water and feed to support timid and green calves
