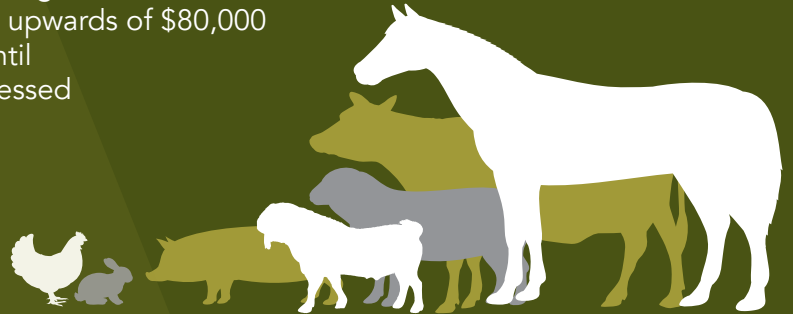


COMMUNITY CORNER

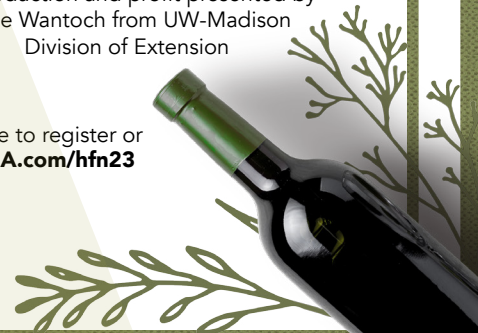
